



Qualification Requirements

America's Camp was established expressly to serve children who lost a parent or sibling as a result of the attacks on September 11th, 2001, and to serve children or siblings of firefighters and law enforcement officers lost in the line of duty at any time. This is central to the charter of the America's Camp Foundation. To carry out this mission, we are required to qualify families as part of our enrollment process.

To assist us with verification, we ask that you provide documentation which will qualify your child(ren) to participate. Please send us a copy of the birth certificate for each camper being enrolled. In addition, please provide documentation confirming the loss of the child's parent. A death certificate or other recognized document can be submitted. Families who have suffered the loss of a parent as a result of rescue/recovery work at the WTC site should contact America's Camp regarding additional required documentation.

Your child's enrollment at America's Camp becomes official once we have received these documents along with the completed enrollment application form. These papers can be mailed to the camp office:
